- Little Flower Catholic School opened its doors in 1948 and currently serves Preschool-Eighth Grade students who reside in Springfield and many of the surrounding communities. We accept students of all faiths. We offer both full and part-time preschool options for three and four year olds.
- Little Flower Catholic School is recognized by the Illinois State Board of Education and the Diocese of Springfield in Illinois.
- Catholic identity is evident in the classrooms and throughout the school.
- The children attend Mass each Wednesday as a school. Students have an opportunity to plan and participate in Masses throughout the year.
- Students participate in many service projects and donate to several charitable causes each year including Lenten and Advent projects which have raised as much as \$5,000.00.
- Faculty members are degreed and hold proper certification as required by the Illinois State Board of Education and the Diocese of Springfield in Illinois.
- Standardized achievement test scores are consistently above the national norm.
- Little Flower Catholic School has a state of the art computer lab with a full-time teacher and Internet capability. The lab houses a Smartboard to fully integrate technology into the other subject areas.
- Our Science Lab allows students hands-on opportunities to explore the scientific method through experiments and observations.



- School begins at 8:00 a.m. and ends at 2:45 p.m. Students may arrive at 7:30 a.m. We offer a Before Care and After Care Program (LAP) for an additional fee. A summer program is also available to students and parishioners in grades PreK-8.
- Our building is locked during the school day for the safety of our staff and students.
- Our students wear uniforms in grades K-8. The plaid uniform can be purchased through Dennis Uniforms, Luers, and Lands End. A white or red polo/shirt may be worn in both long and short sleeved options. Navy walking shorts, skorts, pants, and sweatshirts in either red or navy are included in our dress code.
- We offer an on-site hot lunch program. We participate in the Federal Lunch Program and offer free/reduced lunch for those who qualify.
- Our students attend Art, Music, P.E., Computers, and Library classes throughout the week. Many of our students also participate in Band, Scholastic Bowl, Science Fair, History Fair, Choir, Student Council, Scouts, and an after-school Spanish program.
- Little Flower Catholic School offers support for children with different learning needs. We are fortunate to employ three teachers in our special education department who work with our students with learning differences to support the curriculum. One of these teachers is a Speech/Language specialist who works with our students on-site.
- We are a Title I school with two teachers who provide math and reading support for those that qualify.
- We offer a Challenge program for children who are academically talented as well. Students are selected for this program based on standardized tests and teacher recommendations.
- A school counselor is available to all students at the request of a parent.
- Tuition remains affordable due to parish subsidy and support. Tuition assistance is available. Parents may qualify for the Tuition Tax Credit of \$500.00 and Transportation Reimbursement each year.
- Sports currently offered include softball, baseball, volleyball, basketball, cross-country and track.
